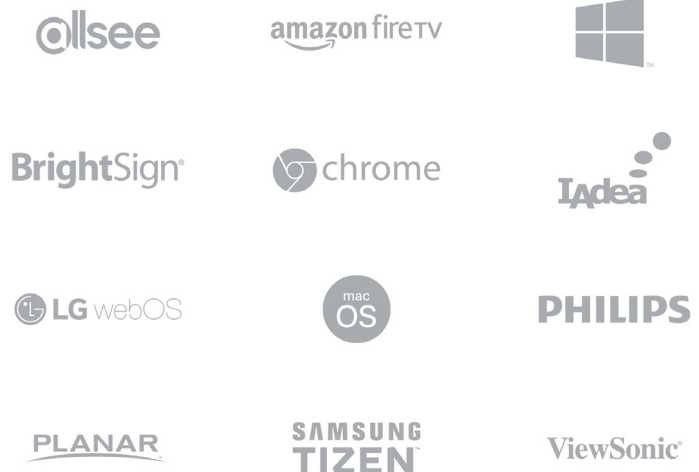


2. SELECT A SUPPORTED HARDWARE DEVICE
