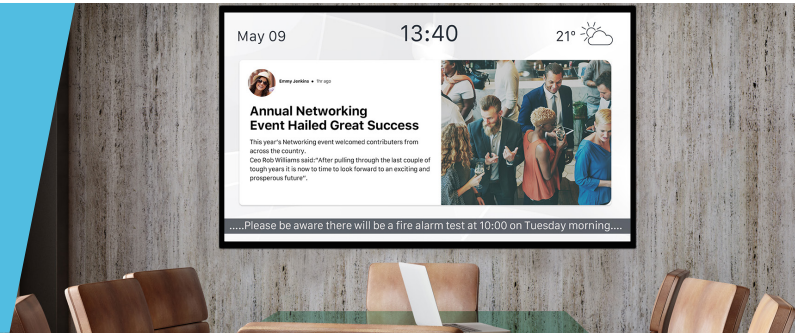


Standard Licence and Web Content Licences Explained
